On the Company

- Operates as a business jet management, aircraft sales/acquisitions and air charter company under FAA Part 135 Regulations
- Founded by jet pilot Casey Miller in 2006, expanded with Solomon Short in 2011, as co-owners
- Manages the largest, newest fleet of 30 client-owned light jets in the United States
- Headquartered at McClellan-Palomar Airport, Carlsbad, CA
- Aircraft located at Carlsbad, Van Nuys, Hawthorne, Santa Ana, Long Beach, Fresno, CA; Colorado Springs, CO; Scottsdale, AZ; Houston, TX; Redmond, OR; Nashville, TN

On the Team

- Average age of 35 employees only 37, with both owners under 40
- Most team members are pilots: Collectively logged 87,469 flight hours as of Q4 2016

On the Fleet

- Composition: Citation Sovereign, XLS+, CJ4, CJ3, CJ2, M2, Embraer Legacy 500, Phenom 300, Phenom 100
- Average aircraft age only 3.7 years, youngest fleet in the charter business
- Ranks number 9 (upper 1.2 percent of market) of all jet aircraft management companies in the U.S.
- Ranks number 33 (with 15 jets under charter) of more than 500 U.S. jet charter operators

- 99.96 percent flight completion for 33,000 flights over ten years
